Instrument Classifier (ICL)

- Writing on Clipboard -Crutches
- Stitches
- Scalpel
- Needle
- String
- Staple

Body Classifier (BCL)

- Carrying someone on shoulders
- Dog bite cheek
- Describing how a person feels

Descriptive Classifier (DCL)

- <u>Size</u> of doorstep
- Location of cast
- Draining of fluid

Body Part Classifier (BPCL)

- Specific body part mentioned
