# Translating Humor

- Must be school-appropriate.
- Must make sense in ASL.
- Must convey the humor.

# Translating Humor

Most humor is language dependent.

Therefore, it is language-specific.

# Translating Humor

**Humor requires:**

the use of words that **sound** funny,  
words that **sound** like other words,  
or words intentionally used incorrectly.

**I left my khakis. vs. I left my cah keez.**

**Are you from Tennessee? Because you're the only 10 I see.**

# Translating Humor

Things that are funny when said in English  
are not always funny when said  
in French, Spanish, **ASL**, etc.

Taco means F-U you in Spain.

Middle finger in Japan = Brother

# ASL signers' Use of English and ASL

- Many ASL signers do not “use” English. Therefore, they do not understand English idioms.
  - “drive me crazy”
  - “bored to tears”
  - “running out of time”
  - “hold your horses”

# Transliterating vs. Interpreting

- Transliterating
  - Changing a message from **one form** of a language to another form of the **same language**.
  - Example: spoken English to signed English

# Transliterating vs. Interpreting

- Interpreting
  - Changing a message from one language into a **completely different language.**
  - Example: spoken English to ASL

## Transliterating

## Interpreting

Changing a message from one language into a **completely different language**.

Example: spoken English to ASL

# Transliterating

Deaf people tend to have a stronger understanding of ASL than English - English is NOT a visual language.

When a Deaf person “gets” a lot of English idioms (you can tell by how a signer uses their hands and face) - It’s possible to try transliterating **that part** of the message, *not the whole thing* .

# Transliterating

- Indicate that you are switching from interpreting (*ASL*) to transliterating (*adding English*) by using “quotation” marks around the idiom.

ASL Samples:      **TEACHER THERE** “drive me crazy”  
                         **MATH CLASS** “bored to tears”  
                         **PROJECT DUE** “running out of time”  
                         **WHOA YOU UPSET** “hold your horses”

# Transliterating

- Watch the Deaf person's facial expressions carefully to make sure s/he understood.

I will make faces.

YOU: Sign **UNDERSTAND** or **NOT UNDERSTAND**
